Module Purpose and Objectives	The main purpose of the module is to develop the students' ability to comprehend and analyse oral and written Russian language at basic level. Students will gain practice in the Russian Language in the main language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing).		
Learning Outcomes	 By the end of this module, students will be able to: Write correct Russian sentences by the use of grammar at introductory level. Speak clearly using simple sentences Read and understand basic texts Develop basic communication skills in particular learned contexts 		
Module Content	Russian Language I covers essential topics to build a solid foundation in the language. Beginning with basic greetings and pronunciation, the module progresses to grammar fundamentals such as the absence of "to be" in the present tense, articles, and personal pronouns. Each lesson explores different scenarios, from interactions at the airport and hotel to discussions at work and home, introducing new vocabulary and grammatical concepts along the way. By the end of the module, students gain proficiency in speaking, listening, and reading, preparing them to navigate various everyday situations with ease.		
Teaching Methodology	The module is delivered over a combination of lectures, videos, group discussions, audio visual aids, seminars, tutorials, workshops, case studies. All lecture material and additional information will be available through our Moodle platform.
